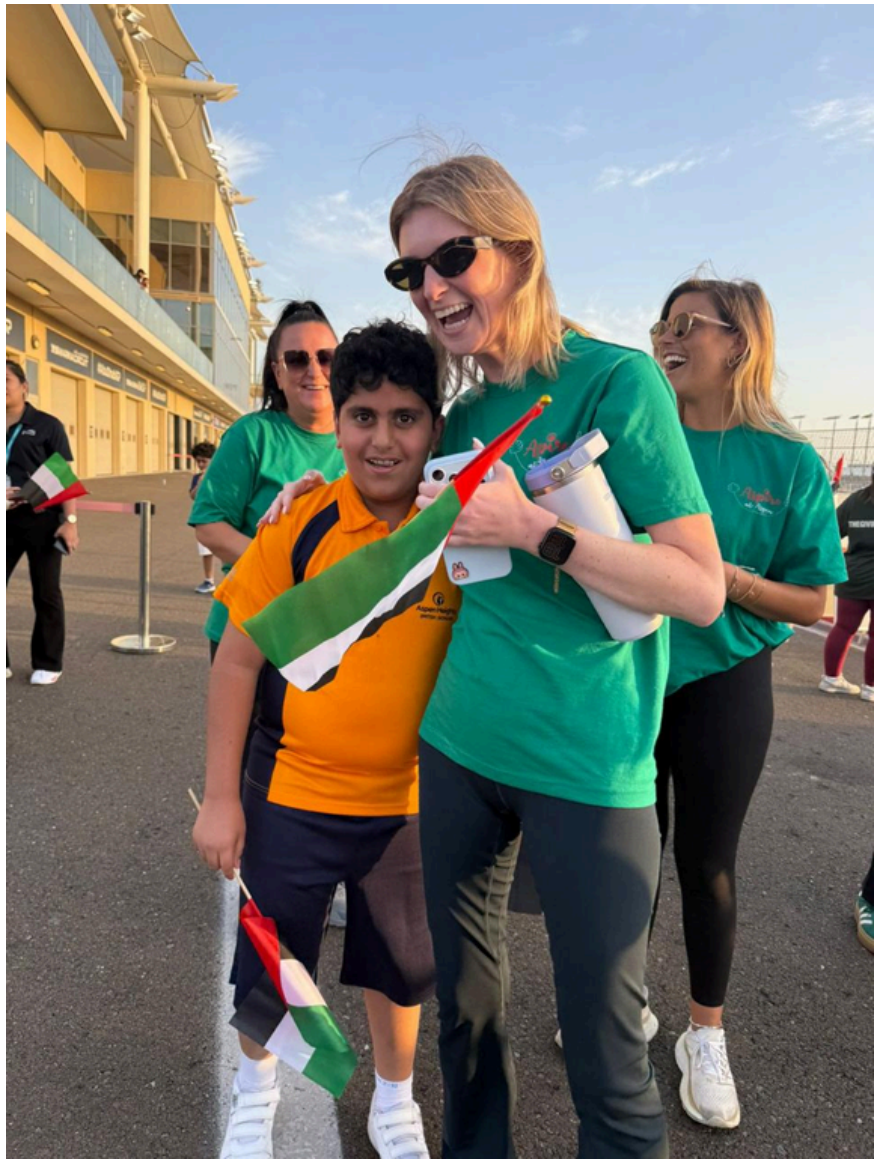

Back to School – Safety Protocol



Stage 1: Before Arrival

No Alert Occurs Procedure:



The student leaves home normally with their parent or guardian to begin their journey to school.



Sudden Alert In Place Procedure:

The student must stay home in a safe internal area away from windows; do not send students to school until an "all-clear" message is received.



En Route Emergency

If an alert occurs while traveling, follow official messages immediately and proceed to the nearest safe place or return home.



Stage 2: Arrival & Handover

No Alert Occurs Procedure:



Students enter the building directly; ideally from designated gates. There are no morning assemblies, and gatherings at gates or sidewalks are strictly prohibited.



Alert In Place Procedure:

Parents and students must enter the building immediately if safe to do so: do not wait outside or drop students off in exposed areas.



Gate Safety

Minimize time spent outside the building and avoid any crowding at school entrances to maintain a clear path for safety.



Stage 3: Inside School

No Alert Occurs Procedure:



Classes continue as usual, but all breaks and activities must be held inside classrooms rather than the courtyard or exposed areas.



Alert In Place Procedure:

All activities stop immediately: students should sit in a low, calm position away from glass while staff work to support their wellbeing.



Shelter Principle

Indoor sheltering is essential, and all outdoor activities are suspended until the safety situation changes.



Stage 4: Dismissal & Return

No Alert Occurs Procedure:



Dismissal is orderly, swift, and staggered. Students are handed over to guardians without crowds forming around the doors, or in corridors. Parents are encouraged to use designated gates for the respective year groups.



Alert In Place Procedure:

Dismissal is suspended immediately; do not evacuate students from the building until the alert is lifted. Parents to collect children **only from designated gates** for their year groups.



Safe Arrival

If an alert occurs during the handover, move to a safe internal place immediately and avoid standing in exposed areas.

Roles and Responsibilities



For Parents and Guardians

- Do not send students during alerts,
- Avoid gathering at gates, and treat official school messages as your main reference.



For Educational Staff

- Guide and organize student movement.
- Confirm student counts, and prioritise maintaining a calm environment to prevent disorder.



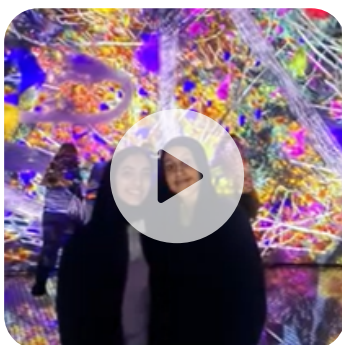
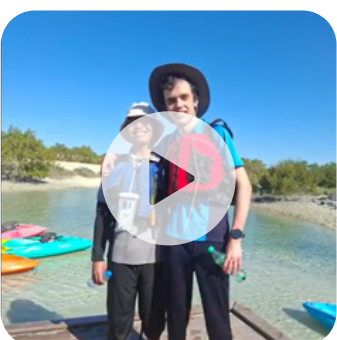
For School Management

During an alert

- Put emergency procedures into action straight away
- Stop student pick-up and dismissal
- Inform parents and guardians
- Make sure students move safely to secure areas
- Guide and train students on what to do if they need to stay inside or evacuate

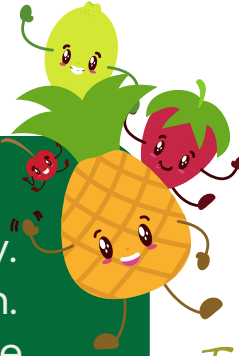

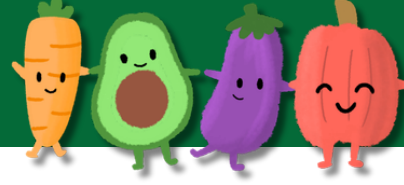
